

🎄 Thorold Secondary School 27th Annual Arts & Craft Show 🎄



Saturday & Sunday, November 19 & 20, 2022 (10am - 4pm both days)

An indoor juried Show, featuring creative Artists & Crafters from across Ontario and beyond. The Show is held at Thorold Secondary School, corner of Ormond St N & St Davids Rd E, Thorold.

Over eighty-five Artisans are selected - displaying their work to an audience of over 4000 in 2019.

The Show is promoted in newspapers, magazines, internet, flyers, cable TV, roadside signs & on local radio stations.

Thorold Secondary School Arts & Craft Show is organized by and admission proceeds benefit Thorold Secondary School. Admission \$3.

Application deadline is June 24th, 2022. Payment must be included with application. Applications received after this date will be considered only if there is space and category availability.

TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

Imported or commercially manufactured goods will not be considered. NO RESALE ITEMS.

- The Show Committee reserves the right to limit the number of vendors in any one category and to make final decisions regarding any entry into the Show.
- Applications are approved based on originality, craftsmanship and display while maintaining a balance of categories within the Show.
- Vendors are responsible for collecting and reporting all applicable sales taxes.

- Each vendor must remain for the full duration of each day and may not tear down any part of a display until after 4:00 pm on the final day of the Show.
- Any vendor intending to sell or give away food to the public must be identified to the local Public Health Department Inspection Division of the Regional Municipality of Niagara prior to the Show.
- Vendors must not display "Reduced Price" or "Sale" signs.
- Cancellations will be accepted up to and including Friday, September 9th, 2022 with 50% rebate of the Registration Fee.
- No refunds after September 9th, 2022.
- \$50 charge for NSF cheques.
- Successful applicants will be informed by email as quickly as possible.

SUBMISSION OF PHOTOS

All new applications should include a minimum of five (5) current photos of the work you intend to sell at the Show, plus a photograph of your setup/display. Photos must be of good quality. If mailing pictures that you wish to have returned to you, please provide a stamped, self-addressed business size envelope. Resumes and other support materials are mandatory for all 1st time applicants. Electronic photos are accepted and can be emailed to tsscraftshow@dsbn.org

SPACE FEES & REQUIREMENTS

8' x 5' = \$175 10' x 10'= \$250 12' (frontage) x 10' = \$300 15' (frontage) x 10' = \$375

- All display booths must have a neat and organized appearance with no frame visible.
- Booths must be constructed in accordance with all safety, health, and fire regulations.
- All exits must be kept clear.
- Displays must not protrude beyond the measured booth dimensions, nor obstruct a clear view of neighboring booths.
- Each vendor must provide their own display unit, backboards, special fixtures, etc.
- All fabric used in your display, such as curtains, tablecloths, etc. must be flame retardant.
- Backdrops must be freestanding; nails and screws are not to be driven into the walls, floors or bleachers. School property is not to be defaced in any way.
- Before taping carpeting/mats onto floors, please check with the craft show organizer.
- Vendors assume responsibility for compliance with local and provincial ordinances and regulations regarding fire, safety and health.
- Electrical lights and 3-prong extension cords *must be CSA approved*.
- Please supply your own electrical extension cord.
- No lit candles or flames are allowed at any time.

SET-UP, TAKE-DOWN & SECURITY

Vendors may set up their booths on Friday, November 18th between 3 pm and 8:00 pm and on Saturday, November 19th beginning at 7:00 am All booths are to be set up by 9:30 am Saturday morning.

Thorold Secondary School will be secured both Friday and Saturday nights.
