Often colleges will host virtual Open Houses and Tours. Check the website of your college of choice for more information.. Most of these events require you to register in advance for the Open Houses.

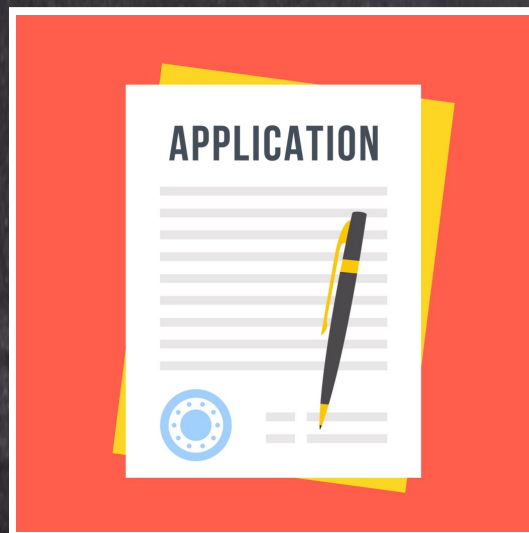
College Fair:

What you need to apply to college:

- ❖ Your Ontario Secondary School Diploma.
(30 high school credits and 20 Community Involvement Hours.)
- ❖ Your Grade 12 English credit.
(ENG4C or ENG4U)
- ❖ You may need certain specific courses, depending on the program you want to apply to.
- ❖ Admission average is usually based on your Grade 12 courses, except if certain other courses are required.



How to apply to college...

www.ontariocolleges.ca

You apply online.

(This usually starts around the middle of October.)

OEN number

You can find this on your timetable or report card.

(If you can't find it, come to Student Services.)

Fees - \$95.00 (non-refundable)

This allows you to apply to 5 college programs, with no more than 3 programs at any one specific college. You may pay through a credit card or online banking.

Deadline: Usually beginning of February

Check your TSS Google Classroom for the exact date! This is the final date to submit your completed application online in order to be considered for all possible programs to which you apply.
